Lupus Decoupled

The power of Drupal, with a modern frontend

- The project aims to provide a complete, fully integrated solution for a headless Drupal - out of the box!
- Keep as many Drupal capabilities as possible, e.g. including authentication, previews, nice URLs or metatag generation
- Provide a great frontend developer experience while focusing on the visual presentation with full control of all the markup and scripts.

What is the Custom Elements module?

- Custom Elements module is part of the Lupus Decoupled project
- The Custom Elements module provides the framework for rendering Drupal data (entities, fields, ...) into custom elements markup.
- Provides
 - The API to build a (nested tree) of custom element objects, with associated cache metadata
 - Allows using modern frontend frameworks like Vue.js instead of Drupal's theming layer.





Dependencies

As part of the Lupus Decoupled stack, we provide:

- Lupus Decoupled integrates various Drupal modules
- Lupus CE Renderer API that outputs JSON
- Custom Elements





Examples

- This is how twitter paragraph could look like:
 - <pg-twitter src="#the-twitter-post-link" title="The title"></pg-twitter>
- And this how a text paragraph with a title field would look when we use a default slot for passing the main text content:
 - > <pg-text title="The title">The html markup.</pg-text>
